The Pilgrim's Journey accepts educational and resource materials on consignment. Consignment items must meet the following standards prior to receipt for consignment:

1. Items must pertain to homeschooling and be currently usable. If a workbook is required for a consigned textbook, it must be available from the publisher.
2. Items must be complete, clean and in usable condition.

- *The Pilgrim's Journey reserves the right to reject any item for consignment or resale at any time, for any reason.*
- *The Pilgrim's Journey will approve pricing of all items whenever necessary at its sole discretion.*

Consignors will receive 50% of the selling price of each item. The Pilgrim's Journey will retain consigned items for a period of twelve months from date of consignment. The Pilgrim's Journey reserves the right to and will reduce the price of consigned items by 25% after six months and by 50% after nine months. Items consigned with The Pilgrim's Journey must be left a minimum of one year from original consignment date. If you choose to remove any books before the one year period ends, the book or books must be purchased at 50% of the current price is on the book. Any items remaining on consignment with The Pilgrim's Journey after twelve months will become property of The Pilgrim's Journey.

The Pilgrim's Journey offers two methods of payment for consigned items. Please choose an option.

→ Mail a check during the first month of each fiscal quarter (Jan, Apr, Jul, and Oct) if the consignee is due \$35.00 or more. A fee of \$1.50 per check will be assessed to cover postage, check expenses and fees.

→ You may elect to not receive checks and simply retain store credit.

Consignment Considerations

Make a list...

Use our Pilgrim's Book List to maintain a record of your items, if you have not already done so.

Price to Sell...

An item that is a current edition and is in "good" condition should be priced at $\frac{2}{3}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ of the new purchase price.

If the item is not a current edition, but is still recent enough to be used, and is in "good" condition, it should be reduced by $\frac{1}{2}$ or more of the new purchase price.

If there is any damage to the item you will need to take this into consideration when pricing.

If you need assistance with pricing your items, we will be glad to assist!

The Pilgrim's Journey accepts donations of items which may have excessive writing or damage and are not resalable. These items will be made available to customers free of charge.

Labeling ...

Individual Items: Please stamp books on the inside front cover or an easy to identify place with the stamps provided at the time of consignment. If your items do not have a place where they can be stamped then use one of the provided labels. Be sure to write your customer number, and desired price to ensure you receive proper credit.

Sets/Groups/Multiple Items: Please stamp all items in the set/group. Indicate the total number of items in the space provided on each item. Use the provided bundling material and place a label on the outside of the plastic bag or stamp the "bundle form" with your bundled items together.
